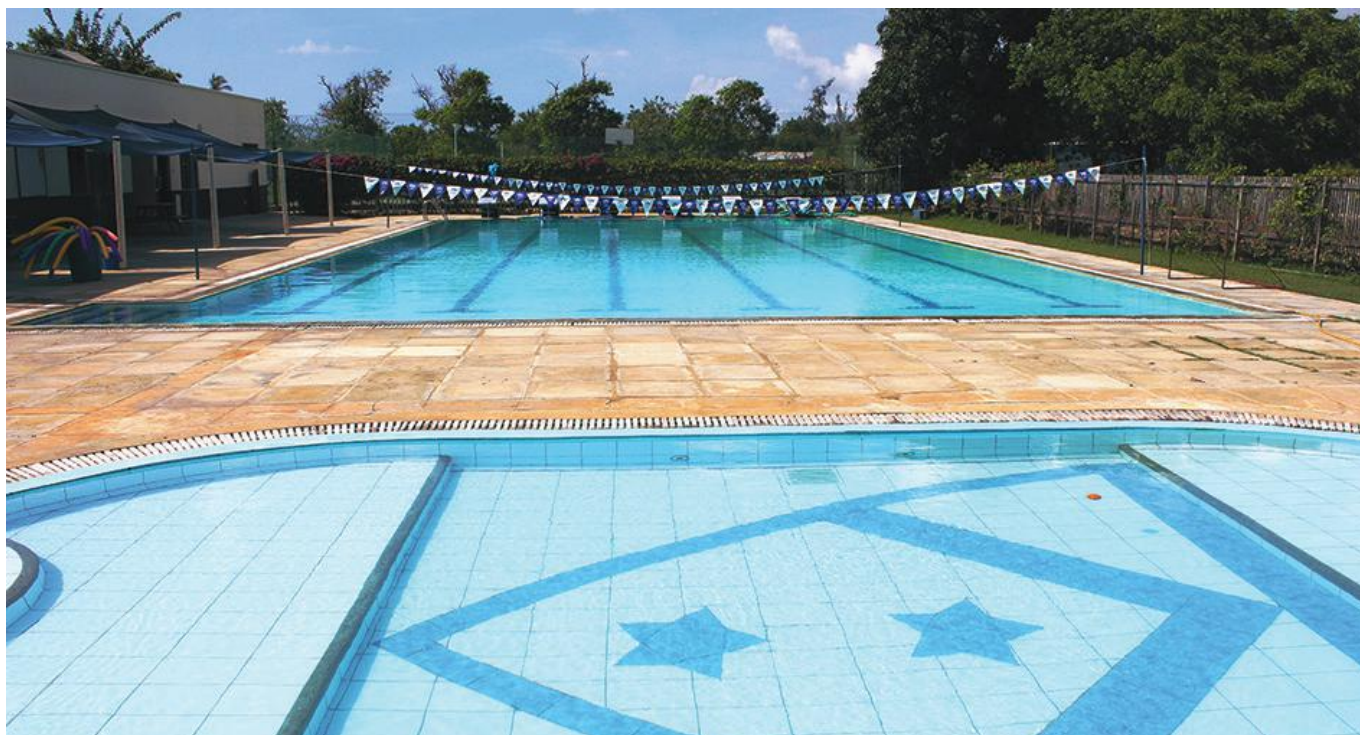

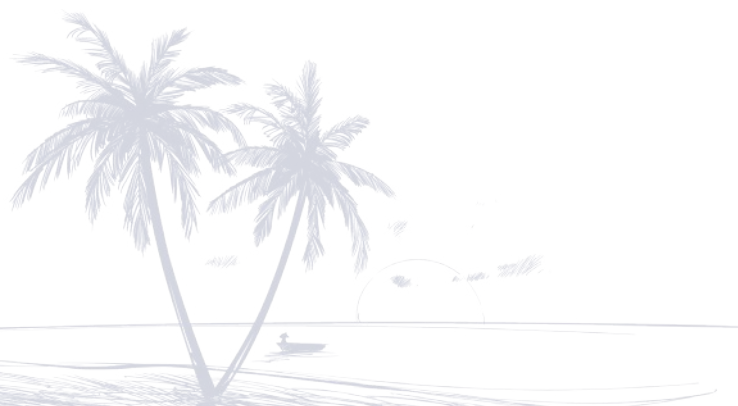
HISTORY OF THE COBIS GAMES

The first Games was opened by former COBIS Honorary President, Sir Roger Fry, for students aged 9-11. 12 schools took part in the inaugural competition with The British School in The Netherlands taking home the trophy.

Since then, COBIS has continued to offer this prestigious international sporting tournament to its network, with the generous support of its member schools around the world. 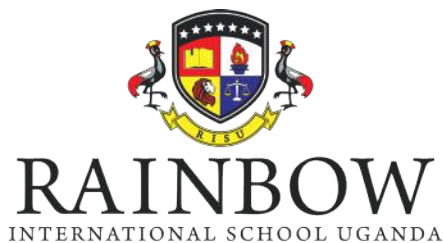


MEADOW HALL

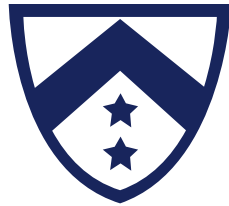
